# **About Kinetic Leather**

## **Types of Leather**

The type of leather is distinguished by distinctive characteristics and hence, varied maintenance methods are required.



#### **FULL ANILINE**

Full aniline, the finest leather available, exudes a beauty like no other. The amount of treatment such as colour or protective pigments used is minimal, showcasing natural markings and colour differences. The luxurious aniline is the most demanding to upkeep.



#### **ANILINE PLUS**

Aniline plus hides are similar to pure Aniline leather, except that they are treated with an additional protective finish to prolong the colour lifespan. The grain remains unchanged, highlighting natural features and patterns.



#### PROTECTED

Lightly buffed and pigmented to ensure consistency in colour and texture, protected hides are durable and resistant to stains. This makes the leather extremely friendly to families and suitable for frequently used furniture in the home.

# NATURE'S SIGNATURE

Naturally formed marks and variations are inherent in leather. It adds beauty and serves as mark of authenticity.



Vein marks are obvious cool marble-like patterns



Horn butts and scraps are scars caused by horn fighting



Scar marks are caused by various reasons, scraped or bruising



Colour variation occurs during the dyeing process as different parts of the hide absorbs the dye in varying amounts



Wrinkles normally appear when thick leather is bent back on itself



Recovered scar marks causes grain line to be faint



Neck lines are mild creases typically found in the neck and shoulder area where loose skin is located



Belly skin is thin – stretch marks and marble-like patterns forms easily



Grain variation is leather obtained from different parts of the animal causes inconsistency in grain patterns



Insect Bite Marks such as ticks, mosquitoes and other bug bites show themselves as tiny spots



Grub marks are caused by larvae penetrating the hide resulting in swelling and hide perforation



Stretch marks appear when the animal grows quickly or gets really fat for a time in life

# TD Trend



TREND is a lightly buffed, leather using premium hides that are specially re-tanned with vegetable tannins & vacuum dried to achieve its tight, flat and yet soft & rich hand touch. Its finishing offers a two-tone effect on surface character to the hides.





## **Leather Care And Maintenance**

#### Cleaning:

- Dust regularly use a clean, dry and non-abrasive cloth or use a vacuum cleaner with a small brush attachment.
- For water soluble stains and grease stains, remove the stains IMMEDIATELY from the surface with absorbent cloth or paper towel. Clean stains in a circular movement, working from the outside towards the center gently.
- Use only HTL approved leather care kit for leather maintenance
- Use of water and/ or other solution is not recommended and should be not be part of your regular cleaning routine.
- For **Nubuck & Suede leather**, use the same procedures described as above. Buff delicately using a dry cloth after the leather has been cleaned and dried, to restore the Nubuck effect.

#### Tips for proper leather care:

- Dust your leather sofa using a soft duster or a dry and non-abrasive cloth weekly or when necessary.
- Use Leather Protection Cream to condition the leather every 3 6 months.
- Use leather cleaning solution to remove stubborn grime and dirt. Avoid excessive force and dry immediately.
- Never use leather cleaning solution for Aniline leather.
- Each type of leather requires individually professional leather care products, so take care when making the appropriate selection. Please refer to below types of leather:
  - Aniline leather 'FULL ANILINE' / 'ANILINE PLUS'
  - Pigmented leather 'PROTECTED'
  - Nubuck & Suede leather special 'FULL ANILINE'
  - Oil & Wax Pull-up Leather special 'FULL ANILINE' / 'ANILINE PLUS'

#### WARNING:

- Avoid using water or any cleaning solution on leather as it can cause leather's protective finish to wear off.
- Always keep leather surface dry. Avoid direct sweat contact.
- Never use the following products or products containing these ingredients on leather. They may result in leather peeling, cracking and discoloration
  - soap, toothpaste, perfume, nail polish, makeup remover, various ointments, lotion or liquid products not meant for leather;
  - Any kinds of chemical, oil, detergent, bleach and other cleaning products;
  - petroleum, alcohol, menthol, camphor, liquid paraffin, butanone, acid, alkali, ethers, ketones, benzene, and other similar substance.
- Place the sofa at least 50cm from any heat source such as hair dryer, heaters or radiators.
- Do not expose your sofa to direct sunlight or strong light source to preserve the colour of the covering.
- Be careful with highly pigmented clothings (e.g. dark denim).
- Keep sharp objects such as buckles, keys and toys away from leather furniture.
- Use of products not recommended by HTL will void warranty.
